Craft Club are **QUILLING** on Wednesday after school until 4.00pm - all welcome in the Library.

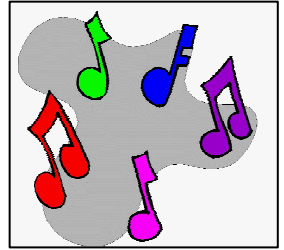
