Thursday - lunch time - Ex3 - ALL CAST CHOIR REHEARSAL - 1.30pm start.

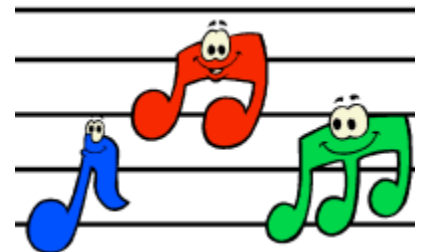
Thursday - after school - Ex2 - LEAD REHEARSALS until 4.45pm
