Literacy Focus: Spelling Tip -

These are words that can easily be confused when adding a suffix. Is it "Hoping" or "hopeing"? The rule is: When adding a suffix to a word, drop the final 'e' if the suffix starts with a vowel. Keep the final 'e' if the suffix starts with a consonant.

For example: Hope: **Hoping**..... **Hopeful**



Christmas Shoebox Appeal: THIS IS THE FINAL WEEK!

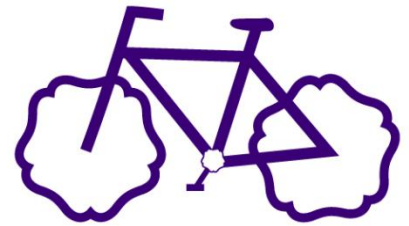

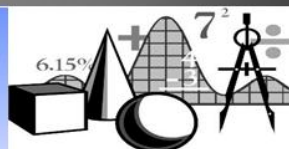
