Music Room Booking

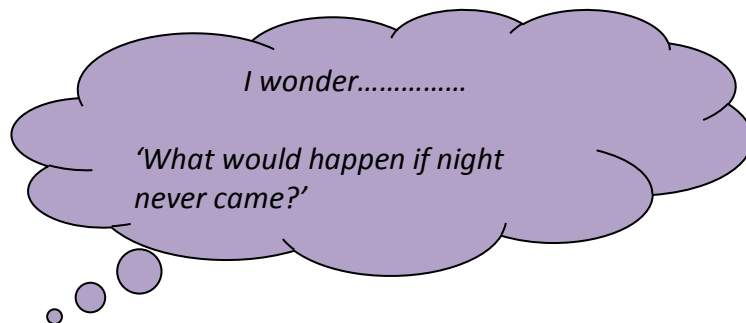
Unfortunately the studio and Ex3 are currently not bookable to use at lunchtimes due to the amount of damage that is being caused to equipment.
