Democracy

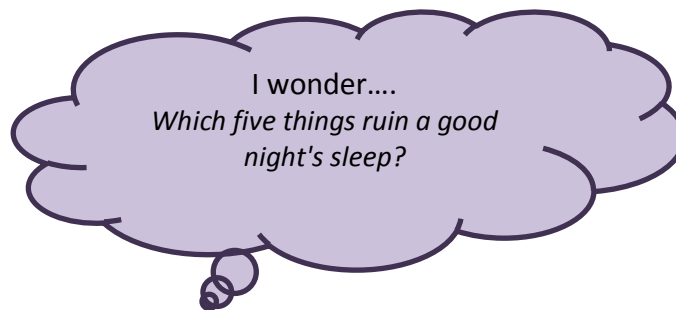
We need to remember the rule for this:

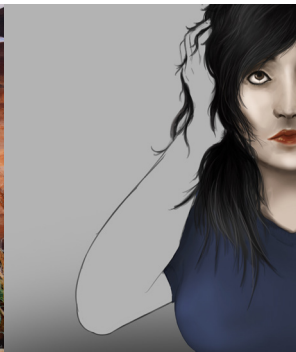
